The Wakefield Municipal Gas & Light Department (WMGLD) is extending an invitation to submit proposals for:

(2) 2,500kW Continuous Rated Natural Gas Fired Reciprocating Combustion Engine Enclosed Generator Set(s)

The WMGLD will receive sealed proposals until **10:00 a.m.**, on **September 15, 2017**, at 480 North Ave, Wakefield, Massachusetts, 01880. Proposals will then be opened and unless obviously non-responsive, read aloud publicly. Proposals received after the time of announced opening will not be accepted.

A pre-proposal meeting will be held at 480 North Ave at **10:00 a.m.**, on **Sep 6, 2017**. Attendance is **mandatory**.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check payable to the order of the Wakefield Municipal Gas & Light Department in an amount of 5% of the total amount of proposal, unless otherwise stated. In lieu of a check, a bid bond may be submitted in an amount of 5% of the total amount of the proposal, unless otherwise stated. The Bond must be from a corporate surety licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, conditioned that the proposer will pay WMGLD, as liquidated damages, the amount specified in the bond unless it enters into a contract in accordance with its proposal. If the proposer fails to enter into the contract with the changes proposed by proposer, if any, and furnish the required performance bond within 10 days from the date on which he is notified that his proposal has been accepted, the amount of his five (5%) percent check or bid bond shall be forfeited to WMGLD.

This proposal is issued under M.G.L. c. 164 § 56D.

The WMGLD reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, including and without limitation the right to reject any or all non-responsive, unbalanced or conditional proposals, and to reject any proposal of any proposer if the WMGLD believes that it would not be in the best interest of the project to make the award to that proposer. WMGLD also reserves the right to waive any informalities not involving price, time or changes to the work.

Agreements will not be valid or binding until duly executed via contract or purchase order signed by an authorized representative of the WMGLD.

WMGLD will process proposals promptly. However, WMGLD will not be liable for any delays in acting on a proposal.
