claiming to have an interest in a mortgage covering real property in **North Reading**, numbered **28 Olde Coach Road**, a/k/a 28 Old Coach Road, given by John G. Andrellos and Monica Andrellos to Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc., acting solely as a nominee for Residential Mortgage Services, Inc., dated January 15, 2010, and recorded in Middlesex County (Southern District) Registry Of Deeds in Book 54183, Page 190, and now held by the Plaintiff by assignment, has/have filed with this court a complaint for determination of Defendant's/Defendants' Servicemembers status.

If you now are, or recently have been, in the active military service of the United States of America, then you may be entitled to the benefits of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act. If you object to a foreclosure of the above mentioned property on that basis, then you or your attorney must file a written appearance and answer in this court at **Three Pemberton Square, Boston, MA 02108** on or before **October 7, 2019** or you may lose the opportunity to challenge the foreclosure on the ground of noncompliance with the Act.
