and to all persons entitled to the benefit of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act, 50 U.S.C. c. 50 §3901 (*et seq*):

Nationstar Mortgage LLC d/b/a Mr. Cooper

claiming to have an interest in a mortgage covering real property in **North Reading**, numbered **37 Mt. Vernon Street**, a/k/a 37 Mount Vernon Street, given by Jodi A. Bebchick to Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc. acting solely as a nominee for Countrywide Bank, FSB., dated August 29, 2007, and recorded in Middlesex County (Southern District) Registry of Deeds in Book 50025, Page 519, and now held by the Plaintiff by assignment, has/have filed with this court a complaint for determination of Defendant's/Defendants' Servicemembers status.

If you now are, or recently have been, in the active military service of the United States of America, then you may be entitled to the benefits of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act. If you object to a foreclosure of the above mentioned property on that basis, then you or your attorney must file a written appearance and answer in this court at **Three Pemberton Square, Boston, MA 02108** on or before **October 21, 2019** or you may lose the opportunity to challenge the foreclosure on the ground of noncompliance with the Act.
