## COMMUNITY PLANNING ANNOUNCEMENT OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Town of North Reading ("Town" ), through the Town Administrator's Office, is seeking proposals from experienced urban planning and engineering firms for a conceptual design plan and feasibility study for the redevelopment of underutilized properties near the intersection of Route 28/Main Street and Route 62 Winter Street. The project will include a conceptual design showing several parcels redeveloped in a village center style development, with a section of the Route 28 commercial corridor reimagined as a defined, mixed-use downtown district. The project also includes an evaluation of wastewater treatment options to enable such development.
